1. STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL: You have the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. §94920(b) Class day means, except for home study or correspondence, a day on which students were scheduled to attend a class session.
